



Application Fee

A non-refundable application fee for Kindergarten to Year 6 of \$75 and Years 7–12 of \$100 is to be paid with an application form for enrolment at St Brigid's College.

Acceptance Fee

A non-refundable acceptance fee for Kindergarten to Year 6 of \$100 and Years 7–12 of \$200 is payable on acceptance of the first child of a family at St Brigid's College.

Entrance Deposit

A refundable entrance deposit of \$300 for boarding students is also payable on acceptance of a place in the boarding section and is held for the duration of the student's education.

Fee Concessions

In keeping with the Mercy Ethos of St Brigid's College fees and charges are kept to a minimum. Where parents are experiencing financial difficulties and where families hold Health Care Cards, concessions are available. Please contact the Bursar with fee concession queries.

Building Levy

A compulsory building levy of \$300 is charged on each annual account.

Parent Forum Association

The subscription for the Parent Forum membership is \$100. This charge is included on the annual account.

Payment of Accounts

Annual accounts will be raised in January 2009. Payments should be directed to the accounts department when remitted by post or delivered by hand to the Senior School Office. Cheques should be crossed 'not negotiable' and made payable to St Brigid's College. Fees can be paid weekly/fortnightly/monthly via a direct debit from a specified bank account at no additional expense to the parent. Further information may be obtained from the College Assistant Bursar.

Boarders Insurance

A contents insurance policy of \$20,000 is recommended for boarders at a cost of \$60. Claim excess is \$50. To effect cover please register name with the Bursar.

Insurance

The College Board has insured all students against accident or injury 24 hours per day for 12 months effective 1st January 2009 through Catholic Church Insurances Ltd.

Overseas Students

Where students are admitted to Australia on a private full fee overseas student visa, fees and charges are covered by the full fee overseas schedule and policy statement.

Commonwealth Isolated Children's Allowance

In certain circumstances a basic grant of up to \$6,530 may be obtained from the Commonwealth Government free of means testing. Additional allowances may be available subject to family income test. Details of allowances may be obtained from Centrelink, telephone 132318.

State Boarding Away from Home Allowance

An allowance of \$1,215 per annum is payable upon the approval of Commonwealth Isolated Children's Allowance. Application forms will be sent out by Centrelink to parents/guardians who are eligible for the Commonwealth Assistance for Isolated Children.

Travel

Students who reside in the Northwest are entitled to four free return journeys home each year. Enquiries to be directed to the Head of Boarding.

Withdrawal of Students

In the event of a student withdrawing from the College, one term's notice is required or a term's fees will be payable in lieu of notice. In the event of a transfer from boarding to day scholar, a full term's notice is required. Notice of withdrawal must be in writing and directed to the Principal.

College Diary/Organiser

Years 2–12 will be supplied with a school diary. The \$16 charge is included on the annual account.

Dancing Program

Pre-primary to Year 5 are charged \$38 on annual account for the Primary School Dance Program.

Activities Fee

An annual activity fee of \$70 for Kindergarten to Year 5, \$120 for Year 6, \$150 for Years 7–10 and Year 12, and \$250 for Year 11 will be charged to cover anticipated excursions, socials and the Enlighten program.

Camp Fees

Camp Fees of \$280 for Years 6–10 and Year 12 will be charged to cover transport, camp and camp activities.

Interm Swimming

Years 1–5 will be charged \$38 on the annual account for the interm swimming program.

Mathletics/Spelldrome

Years 1–10 are charged \$25 for Mathletics and years 1–5 are charged \$10 for Spelldrome access to the online learning system.
