



### **Application Fee**

A non-refundable application fee of \$100 is to be paid with an application form for enrolment at St Brigid's College.

### **Acceptance Fee**

A non-refundable acceptance fee of \$250 is payable for all students on acceptance of our offer of a place at St Brigid's College.

### **Administration Fee**

An annual fee of \$1,000 is payable by all overseas students including those who gain permanent residency.

### **Curriculum Council**

The Curriculum Council of Western Australia charges an administration fee for all overseas students. This administration fee will be charged to student accounts.

### **Entrance Deposit**

A refundable entrance deposit of \$1,000 for overseas students is payable on acceptance of a place at the College and is held for the duration of the student's education.

### **Activities Fee**

An activities fee of \$250 per annum will be charged to cover anticipated excursions, socials and the annual camp.

### **Building Levy**

A compulsory building levy of \$500 per student is payable per annum.

### **Guardianship**

All overseas students must have an appointed guardian. The guardian must be over 25 years of age and reside full time in Australia. They are expected to attend parent nights and liaise with teachers and boarding section staff. Please see the separate Guardianship forms for details.

### **Insurance**

The College Board has insured all students against accident or injury 24 hours per day for 12 months commencing 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008 through Catholic Church Insurances Ltd. A contents insurance policy of \$16,000 is compulsory for all overseas students at an annual cost of \$60. The claim excess is \$50.

### **Medibank Private Health Insurance**

Government regulations require the payment of Medibank Private Health Insurance for the duration of the student visa approval. An initial payment equivalent to the first year is payable on acceptance. The current rate is \$342 per annum. The remainder of the insurance cost will be invoiced by the College when the length of the student visa is established.

### **Parent Forum Association**

The subscription for the Parent Forum membership is \$100. This charge is included on the College's annual account.

### **Cathedral Contribution**

A levy of \$20 per family is charged on each annual account.

### **Withdrawal of Students**

In the event of a student withdrawing from the College, *one term's notice is required or a term's fees (day or boarding) will be payable in lieu of notice.* Notice of withdrawal must be in writing and directed to the Principal.

### **Payment of Accounts**

Annual accounts will be raised in January 2009 and are payable by the due date noted on the invoice. Payments should be directed to the accounts department. Electronic and credit card payments can be arranged by contacting the accountant.

### **Refund Policy**

The College operates under the Ministry of Education refund guidelines, a copy of the policy may be obtained from the Registrar. This policy is only applicable for the first semester of attendance at St Brigid's College.

### **Course of Study**

St Brigid's College is registered on the Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Courses for Overseas Students (CRICOS) to accept Secondary Students from Years 8-12 CRICOS Code (00451F).
